As I recall you and I inherited this action from a recent meeting, on the basis of "Just Do It".

Having read the notes attached, the approach there seems to be to plan carefully and try to get everything right the first time, which would be ideal, but time consuming and subject to delay.

May I suggest the following as an outline agenda for an in person "Just Do It" meeting?

1. Introduction - WDCO is changing, and is changing the way it presents itself to the world.
2. Part of that change is to hold a community forum
3. A further part of the change is to revise the website - put the website up on a big screen
4. Anyone on the estate can get in touch with any one of us on the board via our contacts page - show the contacts page - <https://wdco.org.uk/contact/>
5. You can now see our proceedings in an easily searchable , familiar structure , in our document library - <https://wdco.org.uk/document-library/>
 1. at this point pick out one or two documents - perhaps presentations on the Masterplan, and the Social Life assessment - to explain further
6. We have an online Action Tracker <https://wdco.org.uk/action-tracker/> which enables us to manage the responses we expect to get from the development partners
 1. a further opportunity to pick out details on , say, two topics - for brief presentations
7. Questions, suggestions and so on, from the floor. This interaction should perhaps be held until this point, with questions, but no answers, being recorded on the way through.

We have a budget for this exercise which we should commit before the end of the year. The big room in the Redmond Centre might be a good venue. A very big screen would be a benefit, as would a video recording (does Euphemia have recording equipment and budding film producers?) which could then go on the website.

I see lots of benefits to this approach.

- The script almost writes itself
- there are lots of headings and subheadings - any of the board members who would like to present has the chance to
- the delving down takes us into issues we'd like to highlight
- the pace of the presentations can be managed , each item should be short, to maintain the attention of those attending

There are potential downsides:

- we may not attract a large audience - but does this matter - we have a duty to hold a forum, which would be discharged , we would gain experience of holding a forum to feed into future efforts,
- as a group we may not be slick presenters of our material - again a useful lesson to be learned
