The Woodberry Down Pavilion project is led by Hackney Council, Notting Hill Genesis and Manor House Development Trust, and is being delivered by Hackney-based architecture practice RC/YYC with the London School of Architecture.

The project includes 10 up-skilling workshops for young people aged 14-19 years old who live locally to Woodberry Down that are focused around designing a temporary pavilion as part of this year's Hidden River Festival.

Workshops taking place at the pavilion between 13th September to the 5th October introduce a range of built environment professions and career pathways through engaging and creative workshops for a range of ages.
